Call for Applications for Tenure-Track Position in the Department of Sociology and Anthropology The Hebrew University of Jerusalem

The Department of Sociology and Anthropology seeks to fill at least one tenuretrack position beginning October 2018.

The position is open to highly qualified candidates with specialization in areas of social stratification, labor market studies, or economic sociology. Scholars in the disciplines of sociology, anthropology and demography are also invited to apply.

The ideal candidate will articulate a clear and substantial scholarly agenda and has already demonstrated an ability to publish innovative and high-quality research in top-tier journals or books with notable publishing houses. Applicants with insufficient publications may be encouraged to defer their candidacy and apply for a post-doctoral fellowship with the department. Applicants should also note that while we, like other social science departments at our university, invite international scholars to join our faculty, the principal even if not mandatory language of instruction remains Hebrew.

Applicants should submit a statement of academic biography, CV, three published or ready-for-publication items, and at least three letters of recommendation. Applications should be submitted as soon as possible and no later than October 22nd, 2017. We expect to notify candidates if they have the endorsement of the department by late January 2018. Final university approval of appointments is expected by March 2018.
